SECTION 1: Chapter 886 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence
as approved September 17, 1954, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of
\$30,448,534.47 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending
September 30, 1955", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of
Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars to the appropriation contained therein for POLICE
DEPARTMENT, ITEM 1.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars as thus
added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City
Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for
Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary
Expenditures are hereby increased by Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.






