RESOLVED, DECREED, AND ORDERED:

That the following-named street shown on a cross-hatched area on the accompanying map entitled "Prov., RI, DPW-Engineering Office, Street line Section Plan No. 064703 dated December 21, 2002."

VIZ: Fones Alley (portion of) as described in Attachment "A" and shown as a cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan and designated by the letters A-B-C-D-A, having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as a public highway. Said abandonment is specifically conditioned precedent upon the following:

1. The Petitioner agrees to tender the amount of seventy-two thousand (\$72,000.00) dollars in legal tender U.S. currency to the City of Providence.

2. The petitioner shall convey an easement acceptable to the Providence Water Supply Board which will permit retention of its facilities in their existing location, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same and with twenty-four hour access to said facilities, or in the alternative should it be determined by the petitioner that any such facilities need be relocated in order to comply with an intended use, the petitioner shall assume all costs of relocation.

4. No permanent obstructions of any kind shall be erected on the abandoned premises, nor shall parking for motor vehicles be allowed; and, further, appropriate markings shall be made to preserve a fire lane available twenty-four (24) hours per day and seven (7) days per week. Said conditions shall be in accordance with the communication of Marshal David A. Costa, attached hereto as Attachment "B."

Petitioner shall at its own expense convey any easements necessary so as to retain undisturbed existing public utility services.

ORDERED, That the Traffic Engineer be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be place on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further



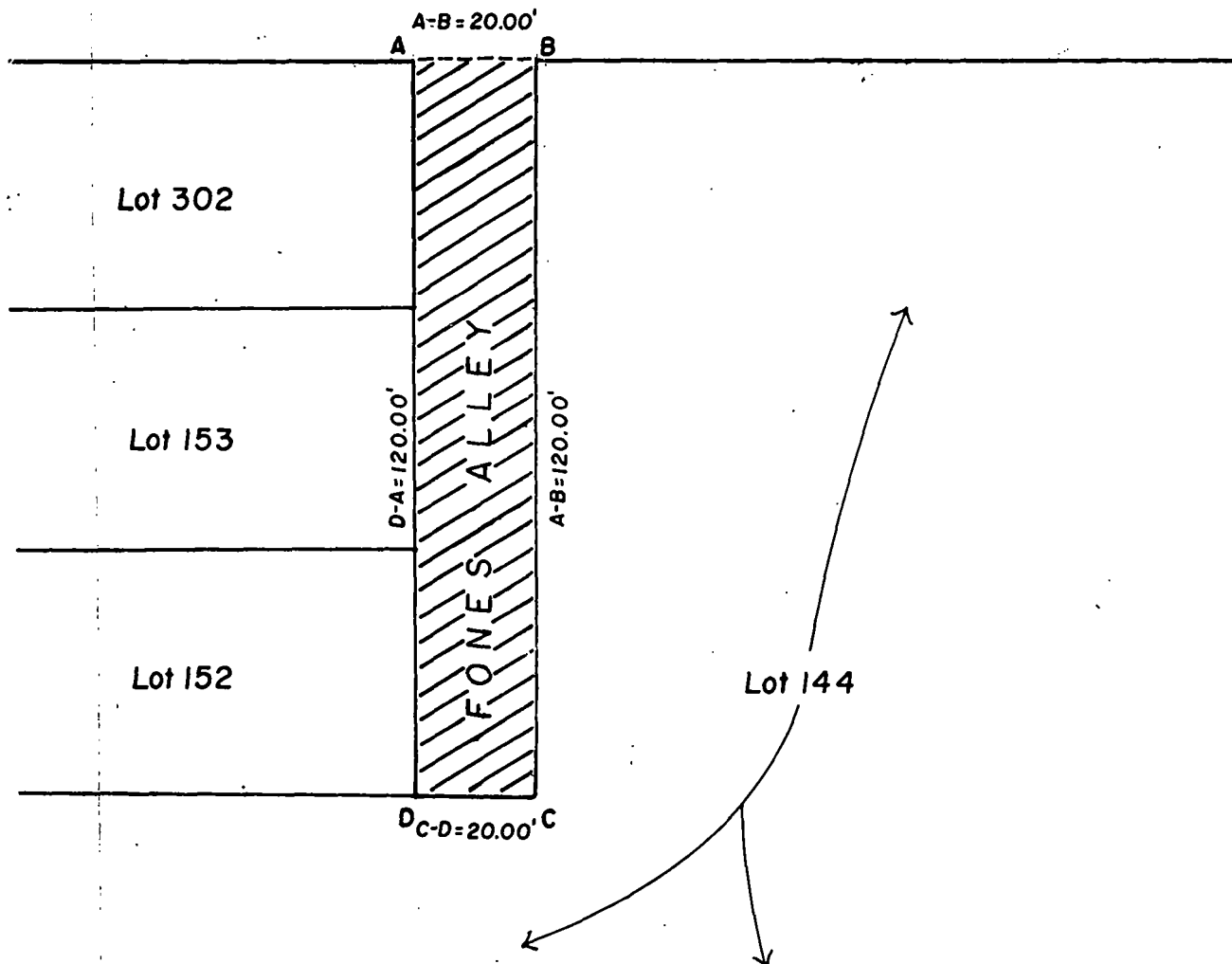

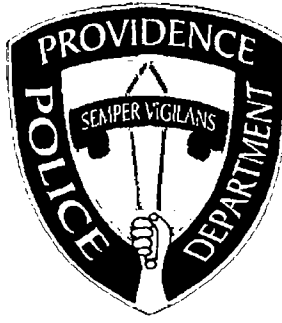

RHODE ISLAND SCHOOL OF DESIGN, having a principal place of business in the City of Providence, State of Rhode Island brings this petition and respectfully represents as follows:

FIRST: Your petitioner is the record owner of land abutting upon the: **northerly, southerly, and westerly** side of that portion of Fones Alley in the City of Providence which is outlined in bold on the plan hereto attached, said portion of Fones Alley to be abandoned being hereinafter referred to as the "Fones Alley Premises." The Fones Alley Premises are bounded and described as follows:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT the CITY OF PROVIDENCE, a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of Rhode Island, in consideration of the sum of SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$75.00) to it paid by the RHODE ISLAND SCHOOL OF DESIGN, an educational corporation existing under the laws of said State, hereinafter called the grantee, the receipt of whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto said grantee, its successors and assigns forever, but without covenants, express or implied,

That parcel of land situated in said Providence and being that portion of Fones Alley lately abandoned by said City for highway purposes bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the westerly line of Prospect Street, said point being a distance of one hundred sixteen and twenty nine hundredths (116.29') feet southerly along the said westerly line of Prospect Street from the intersection of the southerly line of Angell Street with the said westerly line of Prospect Street;

Thence westerly along the northerly line of said Fones Alley, as formerly existing, a distance of one hundred twenty and zero hundredths (120.00') feet to a point for a corner;

Thence southerly along the westerly terminus of Fones Alley, as formerly existing, a distance of twenty and zero hundredths (20.00') feet to a point for a corner;

Thence easterly along the southerly line of said Fones Alley, as formerly existing, a distance of one hundred twenty and zero hundredths (120.00') feet to the said westerly line of Prospect Street for a point for a corner;

Thence northerly along the said westerly line of Prospect Street and also being the terminus of said Fones Alley, as formerly existing, a distance of twenty and five hundredths (20.05') feet to the point and place of beginning.

Meaning and intending to abandon a portion of Fones Alley from Prospect Street 120' to land of Rhode Island School of Design containing 2400 square feet.


The referenced Petition to the City Council, which relates to the abandonment of a portion of the Fones Alley right-of-way, west of Prospect Street, has been reviewed for any impact on the Providence Water (PW) water distribution system. Our records indicate that an 8-inch water main is located within the right-of-way of the portion of street proposed for abandonment. Also, there are water services present, therein, serving buildings owned and operated by Rhode Island School of Design.

Providence water does not oppose this street abandonment provided that the Petitioner prepares a utility easement acceptable to PW (and record the same, thereafter, in City of Providence Land Evidence Records) for the operation and maintenance of its infrastructure within the former street right-of-way—including unrestricted 24-hour access to the same.

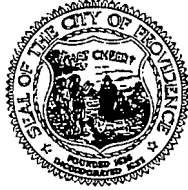

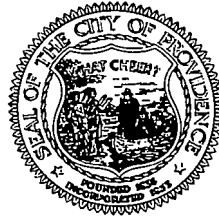

Dear Councilman Clarkin:

The City Plan Commission at its regular meeting on Tuesday, February 19, 2002 reviewed and evaluated the request of the Committee on Public Works that the Commission review and make a recommendation regarding the proposed abandonment of a portion of Fones Alley.

The Commission made the following findings of fact as required by the *City Plan Commission Handbook* Policy No. 1: "Criteria and Guidelines for Approval of Street, Highway and Rights-of-way Abandonment":

1. *A public interest has to be clearly demonstrated. A public interest is defined as one or more of the following: public health and safety, adequate provision of transportation, general improvement of traffic patterns and/or circulation, convenient access to properties, avoidance of a nuisance, significant economic development, preservation of a historical or cultural feature, and improvement of the general welfare of the community.*

This street abandonment is not inconsistent with the public interest. It will provide convenient access to properties, and, as this street is a dead-end, there will be no adverse impact on traffic patterns.

2. *No negative impact is evident on existing land uses, future plans, zoning, safety, health or welfare of the community by the proposed abandonment.*

No negative impacts from this abandonment are anticipated.

3. *All abutting landowners agree to the proposed abandonment.*

The petitioner abuts both sides of this right-of-way.

4. *No physical or legal access will be denied to any land or property in surrounding areas by the proposed abandonment.*

No access will be denied to surrounding areas.

5. *No existing or future public services or facilities need to be protected, provided, or maintained within the right-of-way. An easement retention may be necessary to provide access to, maintain, or provide existing or future service or utility needs.*

It is not known whether public services or facilities need to be protected, provided, or maintained within the right-of-way. The petitioner would need to grant easements if necessary.

6. *The proposed or intended use of the street and/or adjacent properties must be shown on a petition or plan, and such use shall be in conformance with existing zoning and Comprehensive Plan Objectives.*

A petition and plan have been provided. This proposal is consistent with the Zoning Ordinance and Comprehensive Plan.

The Commission voted to recommend to the Committee on Public Works that it approve the subject abandonment with the condition that any necessary easements be granted.



No permanent obstructions of any kind shall be erected on the abandoned premises, nor shall parking for motor vehicles be allowed; and, further, appropriate markings shall be made to preserve a fire lane available twenty-four (24) hours per day and seven (7) days per week. Said conditions shall be in accordance with the communication of Marshal David A. Costa, attached hereto as Attachment "B."

Petitioner shall at its own expense convey any easements necessary so as to retain undisturbed existing public utility services.

ORDERED, That the Traffic Engineer be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be place on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

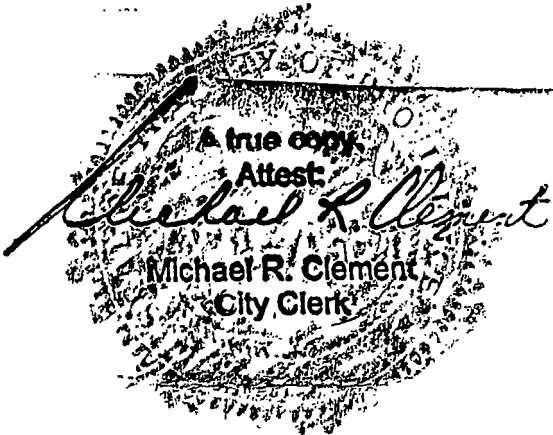



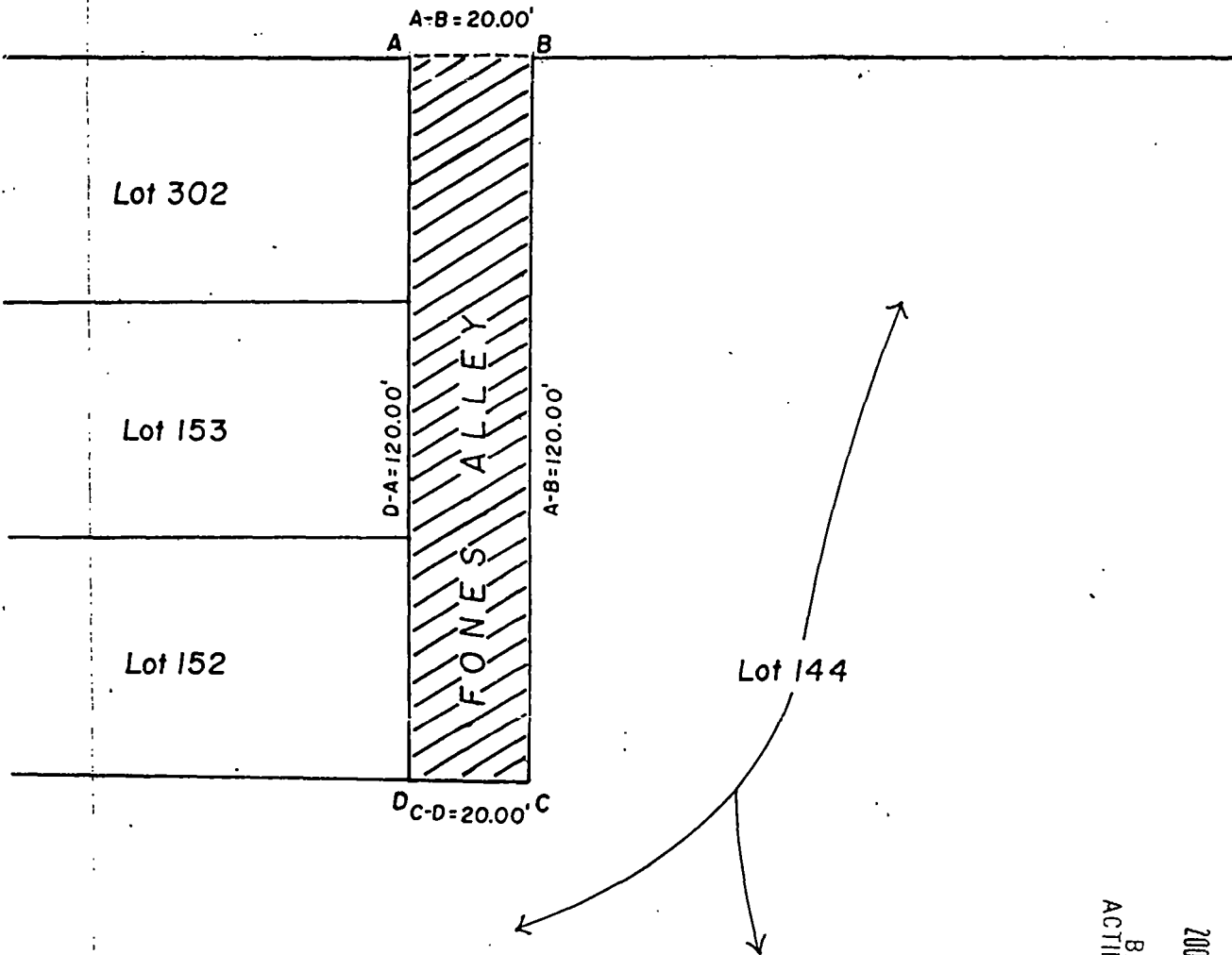
