Dear Property Owner:


Please be advised that the Department of Public Works has inspected the settlement in the public right-of-way in front of your property at 110 Baxter Street. Our determination is that the settlement is caused by a defective sewer lateral. This determination was based upon our inspection of the sewer line, manhole, and a color dye/high pressure water test.

Be advised that under city and department regulations, the maintenance of the sewer lateral is the responsibility of the property owner. This maintenance is from the private property connection, the length of the lateral, to its main sewer connector line in the middle of the roadway (under the roadway).

Should you fail to contact our Engineering Office within seventy-two (72) hours of receipt of this letter to make arrangements for a private contractor to repair the sewer lateral, the Dept. of Public Works, in the interest of public safety, will excavate the public right-of-way and perform emergency repairs to the apparent defective sewer lateral.

After roadway excavation, should it indeed be determined that the sewer lateral was defective, the City shall forward a bill to you for the cost of these repairs (by the City) and if said payment is not received within thirty (30) days, a lien will be placed on your property by the City Solicitor's Office.
