



SUBJECT: Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the re-stripping of the crosswalks in the front of the Berkshire Nursing Home, namely the two crosswalks on Berkshire Street and the two on Berkshire Street and Douglas Avenue.

The DPW - Division of Traffic Engineering has reviewed the request for a crosswalk in the front of the Berkshire Nursing Home. The mid-block crosswalk has been repainted but the request for a crosswalk at the corner of Berkshire Street and Douglas Avenue never existed. Since this intersection never had a crosswalk, this intersection would have to be made ADA compliant in order for a crosswalk to be painted. To make this intersection ADA compliant, handicap accessible ramps would have to be installed first. This type of installation is not performed by the DPW-Traffic Engineering Division. This request will have to be referred to the DPW-Engineering Division for review.
