



Dear Mr. Easton,

In response to City Council Resolution No. 445, dated July 6, 1987 and as a result of my meeting with the Council members on 2/16/89 I submit the following to you.

My recommendation is that a resolution be placed before the city council to upgrade all the street lighting to High Pressure Sodium. This change would be done with request to Narragansett Electric Company to change over about sixteen hundred fixtures per year. It will take seven to ten years to complete. There is no charge to the city to upgrade to High Pressure Sodium Fixtures.

I would also recommend to you that an additional resolution be presented to the Council to retrofit the existing city owned Mercury Vapor fixtures on Atwells Ave. to 150 watt High Pressure Sodium. This Resolution should go to Traffic Engineers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the change over will mean approximately sixteen hundred fixtures per year will be completed, and will take seven to ten years to complete.




