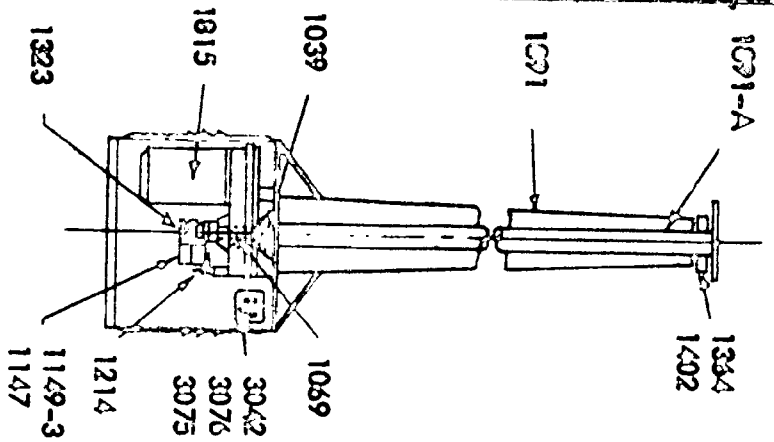


CIRCUIT NO. 2

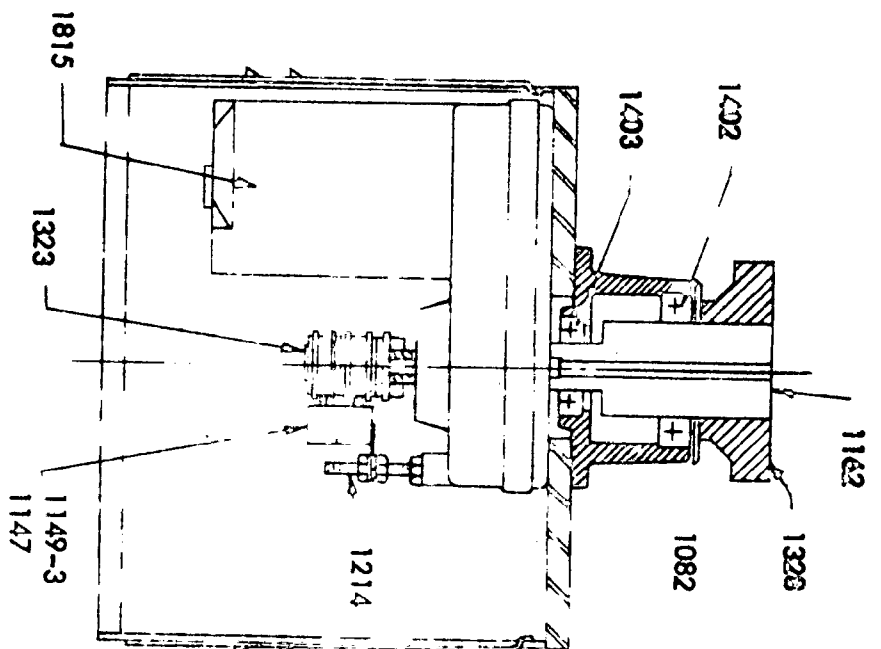

TITLE: WIRING DIAGRAM FOR ROTATOR WHEN SHAFT IS TURNING			NO. 1/33



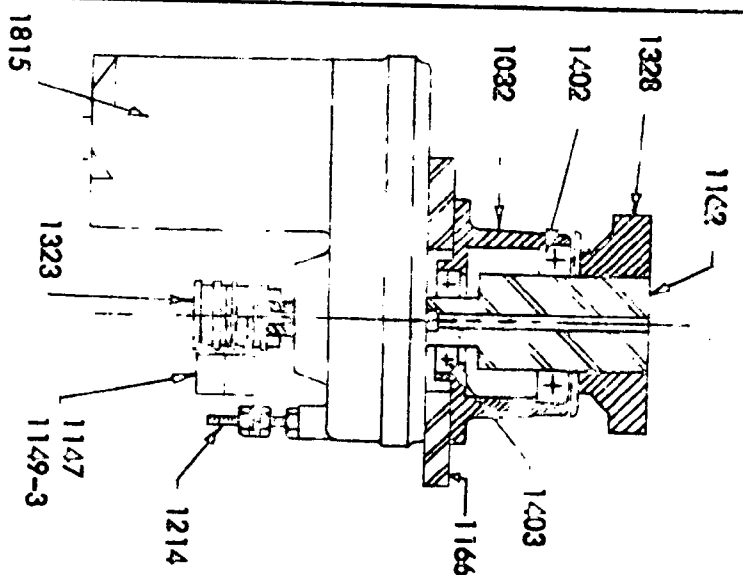

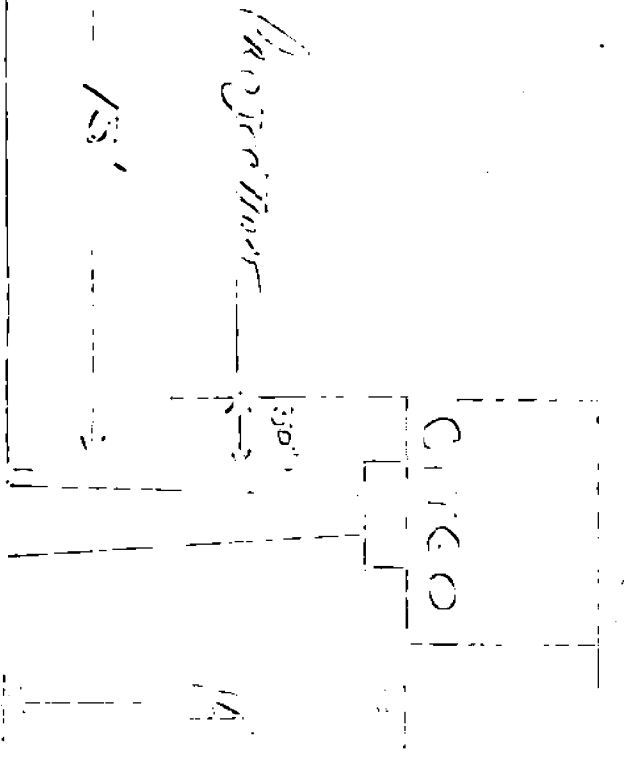
