

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved October 30, 1972

WHEREAS, there is definite need for low rent public housing units in the City of Providence, Rhode Island, for the elderly, and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Providence, Rhode Island proposes to apply to the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development for five hundred fifty (550) Section 23 Lease Back units and three hundred fifty (350) new construction Elderly Turnkey units.
