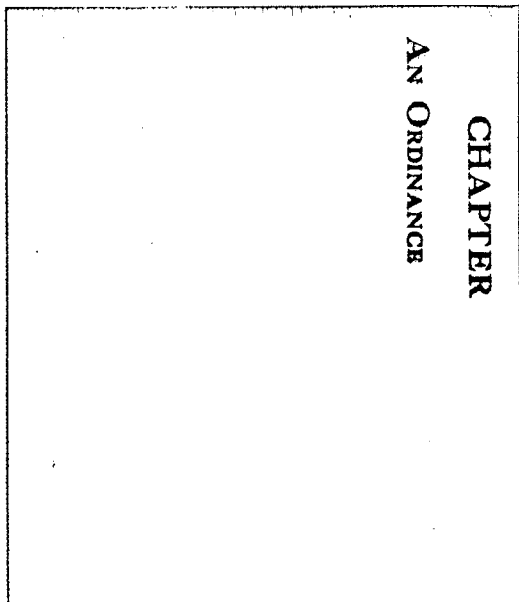

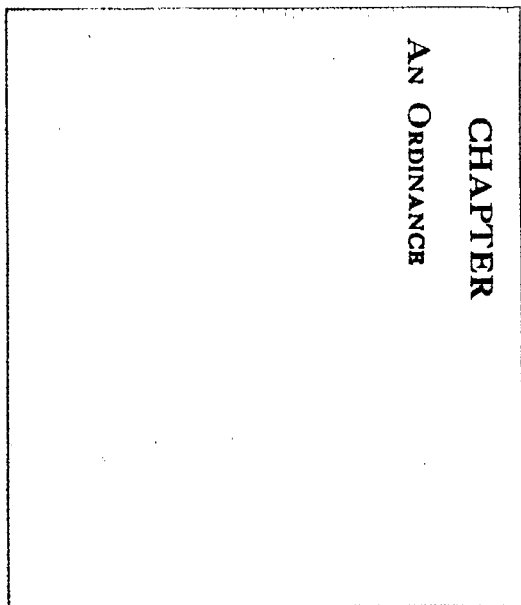

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1424 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 21, 1961, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$42,542,430.35 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1962", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$11,333.80), to RECREATION DEPARTMENT, ITEM 1.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$11,333.80) as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$11,333.80).

No. 86 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XVI ENTITLED TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT

Approved February 15, 1962

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Section 198 of Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances of 1946 as amended is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 198. PENALTIES--PARKING FINES WHEN APPEARING BEFORE
CLERK OF COURT--PROCEDURE

A person charged with the violation of any traffic regulation relating to stopping, standing ~~and~~ parking of vehicles and notified in writing by a police officer to appear to answer such charge before the police court, instead of personally appearing in court, may in person or by one duly authorized by him in writing, appear before the clerk of said court, admit the truth of said charge, and pay to said clerk the designated fine; provided that such appearance, admission and payment be made at the office of said clerk during regular business office hours, within five days of such notification and failure to so appear shall be deemed a waiver of the right to dispose of such charge without personal appearance in court. The right to dispose of such a charge without personal appearance in court may not be exercised by any person who in any consecutive period of twelve months next preceding such charge has been three times in the aggregate adjudged guilty by the police court of any violation of any regulation relating to stopping, standing ~~and~~ parking of vehicles, or has admitted the truth of charges made against him under the provisions of this section.

The payment of the fine to the clerk as herein provided shall operate as a final disposition of the charge, and such proceedings shall not be deemed criminal. Notice of any violation shall indicate the offense charged, and shall also contain such other information as will enable the person charged to take advantage of the provisions of this section."

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

This supplemental agreement entered into this _____ day of _____, 1961, by and between the PROVIDENCE REHABILITATION AGENCY, a public body, corporate and politic, of the City and County of Providence, State of Rhode Island, hereinafter called the "Agency" and the CITY OF PROVIDENCE, a municipal corporation in the City and County of Providence, State of Rhode Island, hereinafter referred to as the "Department of Building Inspection".

WITNESSETH:

Whereas, the Agency and the Department of Building Inspection on the _____ day of September, 1961, entered into an agreement for the inspection of certain nonresidential structures within the "Providence Hill Project Area" and nonresidential structures within the "East Side General Project Area"; and

Whereas, the Agency and the Department of Building Inspection desire to modify said agreement in certain aspects as set forth below.

IT IS, THEREFORE, THE JOINT INTENT OF THE PARTIES:

1. To paragraph 8 of said agreement, dated September 12, 1961, which herefrom the following: "December 31, 1961" and include therein in its place the date 30, 1961.

2. To state that said agreement entered into on the 12th day of September, 1961, the entire paragraph 10 and include therein in its place the following paragraph:

10. The staff persons of the Department of Building Inspection, to be assigned to perform the service of this contract shall be American citizens and other individuals within the said Department of Building Inspection with the training and background to perform the said services.

3. All the terms and conditions of said agreement dated September 12, 1961, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

4. the execution of this Supplemental Agreement is authorized by
Resolution No. _____ of the agency approved _____, 1961.
