WHEREAS, Joseph G. Checrallah, a community leader in our City and a Republican Candidate for the First State Senatorial District, has passed from this life, and

WHEREAS, "Joe" Checrallah, Chairman of the Twelfth Ward Republican Committee, was active in Veterans Affairs, when following his service in World War II, as a Member of the United States Navy, he had served as Senior Vice-Commander; Post Commander of the Disabled American Veterans, and as a Member of the American Legion Post No. 10, in Riverside and the Roger Williams Post, American Legions in Providence, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Checrallah, as a graduate of Central High School, Class of 1936, attended the University of Rhode Island, and later he held Membership in the Knights of Lebanon and the Lebanese American Community Center in North Providence,
