


Dear Councilman Lombardi,

Rhode Islanders Taking Action, Inc. (RITA's Place), a grass-roots HIV/AIDS organization located at 112 Union Street would like to have a fundraising block party to support our organization. We would like to hold the ***Unity is the Key*** Block Party on Saturday, June 14, 1997. We request authorization to close down Union Street between Westminster and Washington Streets (the Shepard Building block). The hours the street would be closed from 10:00 am until 2:00 am. The hours of the block party would be from 2:00 pm to 1:00 am. We have gone before the licensing committee and they have pre-approved these hours depending on the outcome of the City Council's decision. We have corresponded with URI Extension Campus located in the Shepard Building and they do not have a problem with this event taking place. They are, in fact, allowing us to put signage up in their building. This will be held in collaboration with Lupo's Nightclub, Strong Roots, a Johnson & Wales University multi-cultural student organization, and with five university fraternities and sororities. We also have the support of many other churches and community organizations who will be participating in this event.

We have also been in contact with the Mayor's office who has supported us in the past and are supporting this event taking place. We would hope that the City Council will follow the Mayor's lead in this day of unity.
