Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1645 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 23, 1964, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

SECTION 9: CONTROLLER'S DIVISION

That part which has heretofore read: "The number of employees in the CONTROLLER'S DIVISION shall not exceed twenty-four (24)"; shall hereafter read: "The number of employees in the CONTROLLER'S DIVISION shall not exceed twenty-five (25)".

Add: One (1) Clerk Typist II

SECTION 11: DATA PROCESSING DIVISION

That part which has heretofore read: "The number of employees in the DATA PROCESSING DIVISION shall not exceed eleven (11)"; shall hereafter read: "The number of employees in the DATA PROCESSING DIVISION shall not exceed sixteen (16)".

Add: Two (2) Data Processing Machine Operator

Three (3) Key Punch Operator

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 1644 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved September 23, 1964, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$46,159,931.36 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1965", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Eight and 85/100 (\$12,748.85) Dollars to DATA PROCESSING DIVISION, as follows: Item 0-\$12,208.85 and Item 1-\$540.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Eight and 85/100 (\$12,748.85) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by increasing the estimated receipts from General Departments-Data Processing Division by the sum of Eleven Thousand One Hundred Nineteen and 58/100 (\$11,119.58) Dollars and by authorizing and directing the City Controller and the City Treasurer to transfer One Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Nine and 27/100 (\$1,629.27) Dollars from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account are hereby increased by One Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Nine and 27/100 (\$1,629.27) Dollars.

No. 218 AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOLESTING OR INJURING POLICE DOGS USED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE.

Approved April 6, 1965

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to wilfully or maliciously torture, torment, beat, kick, strike, mutilate, injure, disable, or kill any dog used by the police department of the City of Providence in the performance of the functions or duties of such department, or to interfere with or meddle with any such dog while being used by said department or any officer or member thereof in the performance of any of the functions or duties of said department or of such officer or member. Any person violating any provision of this section shall be deemed guilty of an offense.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
