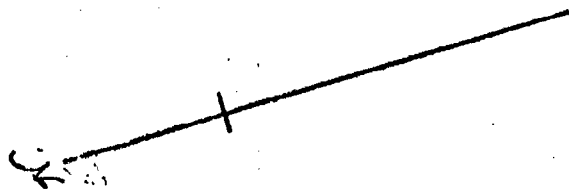

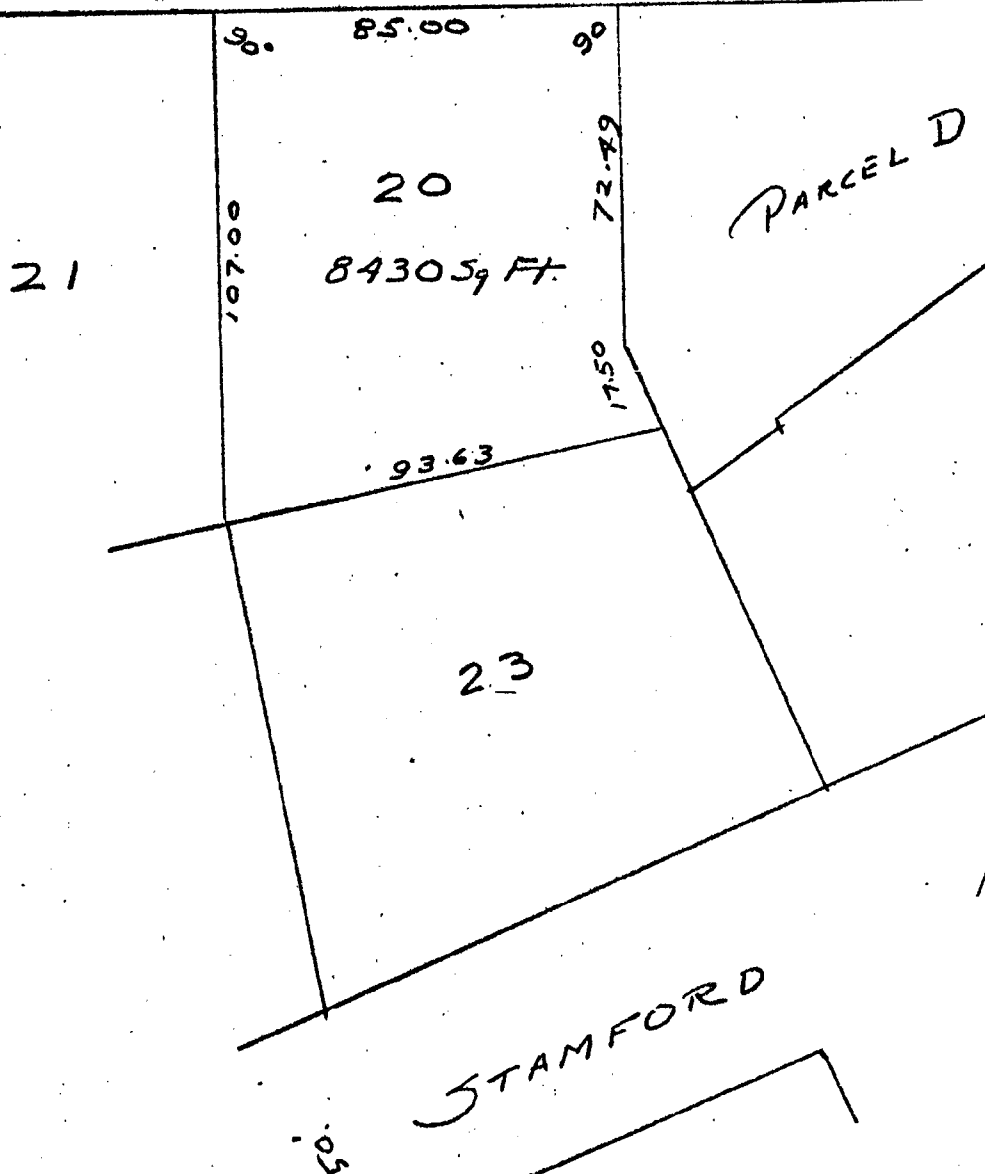

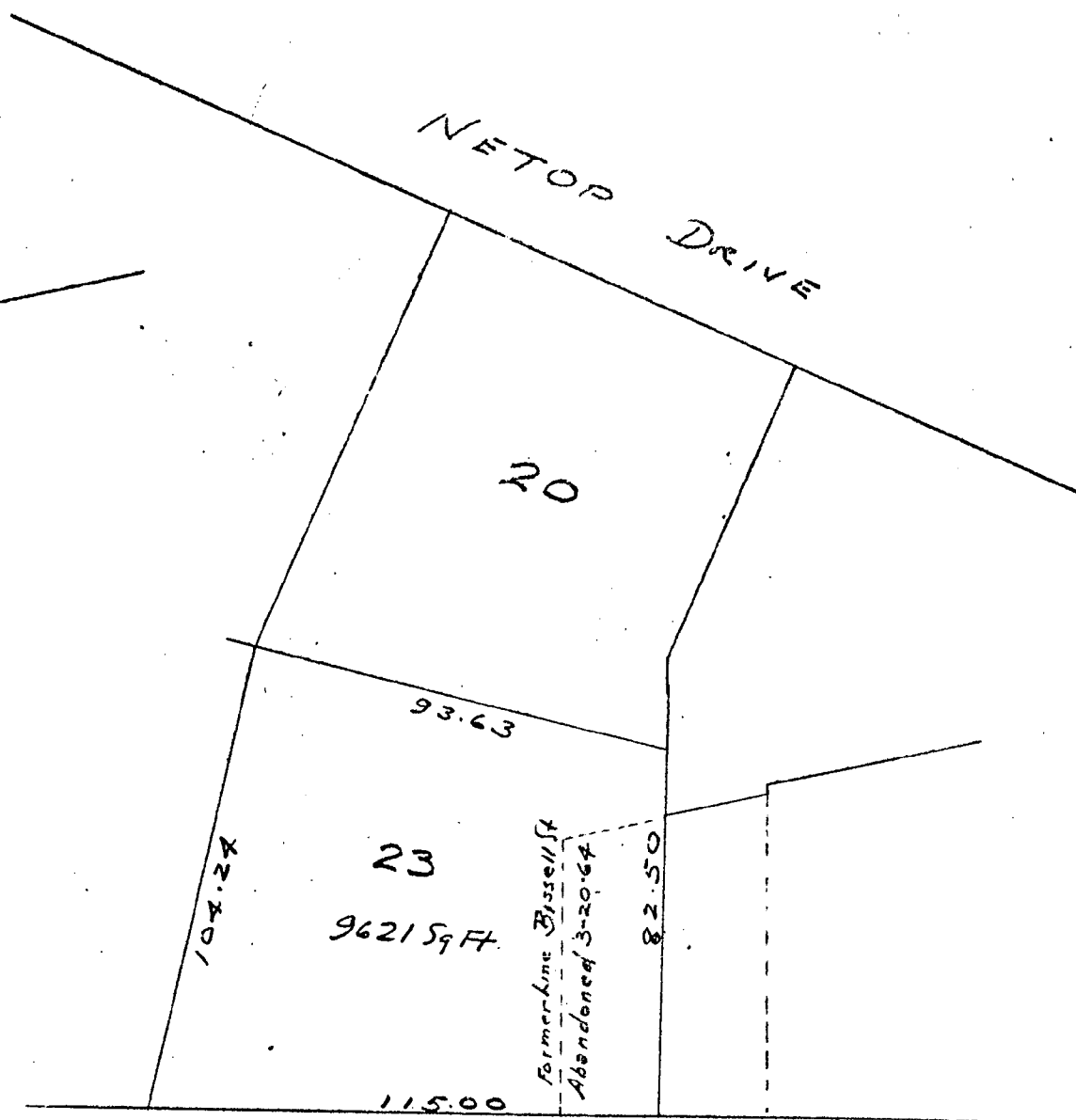
Lot No 7 - "Amendment of Proposed Subdivision

PROVIDENCE - Scale 1"=40' (Revised April 17, 1964)"

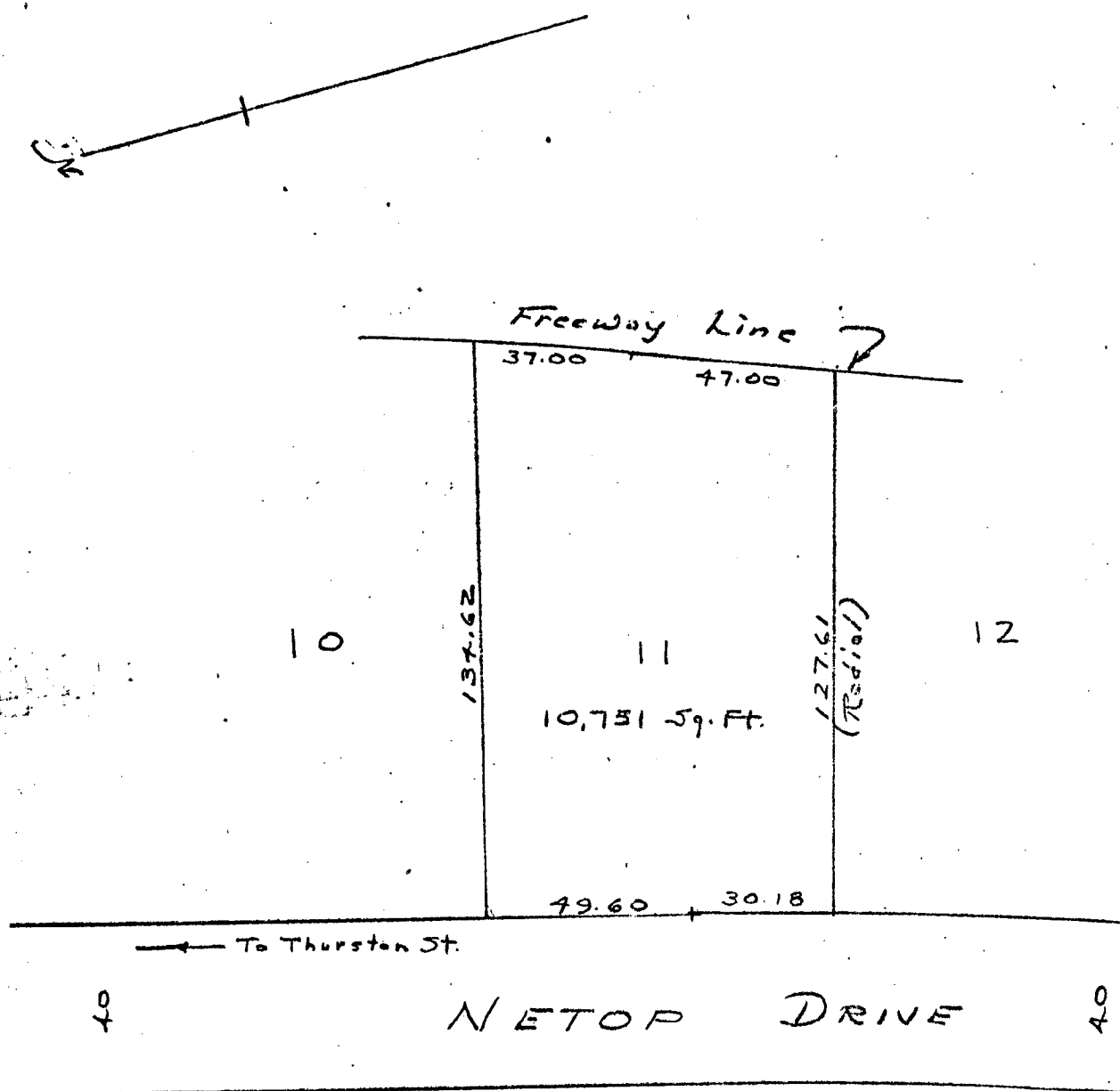


Gentlemen:
