CHAPTER 833

No. 96 AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING CHAPTER 776 BY APPROPRIATING

FIFTY THOUSAND (\$50,000) DOLLARS TO AN ACCOUNT TO BE KNOWN AS "PROVIDENCE CIVILIAN DEFENSE COUNCIL", ITEM 5.

Approved February 19, 1954

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 776 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 18, 1953, and entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$29,679,752.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1954", as amended, is hereby further amended, by appropriating the sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars to an Account to be known as "PROVIDENCE CIVILIAN DEFENSE COUNCIL", ITEM 5.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4: The City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to pay over this appropriation from the General Fund to the Account in the Trust and Special Funds entitled: "PROVIDENCE CIVILIAN DEFENSE COUNCIL". Any unexpended balance remaining in this account shall revert to the General Fund when authorized by the Finance Director.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

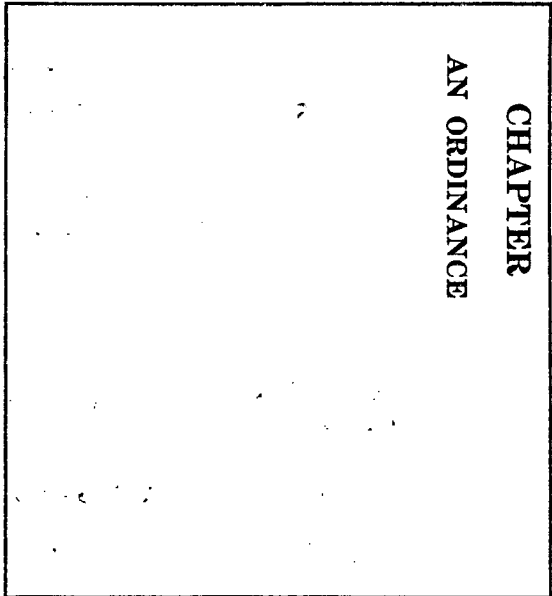

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 776 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 18, 1953, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$29,679,752.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1954", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars to the appropriation contained therein for ZONING BOARD OF REVIEW, ITEM^s 1 and 2. Said sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars shall be apportioned as follows: ITEM 1 - \$300; ITEM 2. - \$100.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

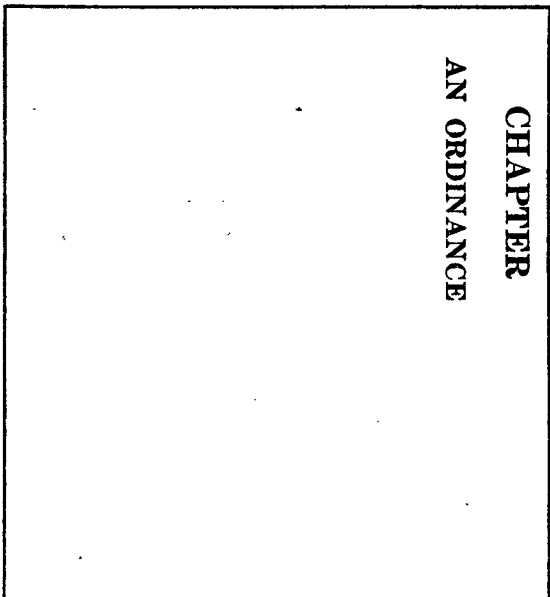

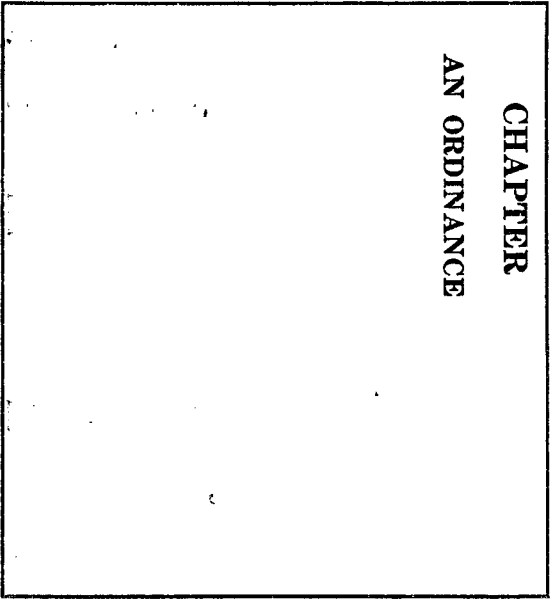
