# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Providence over the last several years has been attempting to bring to the attention of the present administration that it was spending city revenues at a rate which far exceeded its actual or reasonable expected revenues, but to no avail, and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Providence as recently as June, 1980 again attempted to bring to the present administration's attention its irresponsible spending practices, but again to no avail, and

WHEREAS, The City is presently facing a deficit for fiscal year 1981 in excess of Twenty-Four Million (\$24,000,000.00) Dollars and an overall deficit in excess of Thirty-Five Million (\$35,000,000.00) Dollars due to the irresponsible manner in which the present administration has addressed the City's fiscal needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence respectfully requests that the Auditor General of the State of Rhode Island immediately proceed to investigate the City's present fiscal situation and report its findings to this body along with recommendations as to what steps this body can take to alleviate the City's fiscal crisis.
