WHEREAS, Robert McGivney an employee of the Providence School Department was involved in the purchasing functions of that Department, and

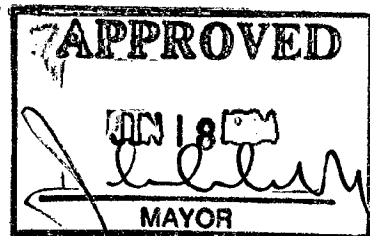
