PETITION FOR STOPLIGHT\* HOPE AND CYPRESS

We the undersigned believe that there is an urgent need for a stoplight at the corners of Hope St. and Cypress St. The main reasons are that:

1. Cypress St. is the main street to Route 95. People living on the East Side and working downtown come home this way.
2. At peak hours in the morning and afternoon, school children walk to Martin Luther King, Jr. school, and to Holy Name. The crossing guard at this corner has stated that many times people do not stop for her and one child has already been struck by a car ~~last~~ 3 years ago.
3. Hope St. is also a main route to many living on the East Side and is heavily travelled.

In conclusion, we feel a stoplight would prevent many accidents, would aid a severe congestion problem, and would make the way to school safer for many school children.

Also - we suggest a stop sign on each side of Belair Ave - so traffic stops before going onto Cypress St.

Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the accompanying Petition of Sarah M. Keegan, 10 Belair Avenue, Et Als, for the installation of a Motor Vehicle Traffic Signal Light at the intersection of Hope Street and Cypress Street, and the installation of a STOP control along Belair Avenue at its' intersection with Cypress Street.

Disposition: Our survey showed that warrants exists for the installation of a traffic signal. We have placed this location on our priority list to be installed when funds are available. As for the intersection of Belair Avenue and Cypress Street, our survey showed that there are no warrants for any control at this intersection. During a two hour period, there were only 14 vehicles travelling on Belair Avenue. In addition, the accident history is excellent, no accidents being reported in four years.
