

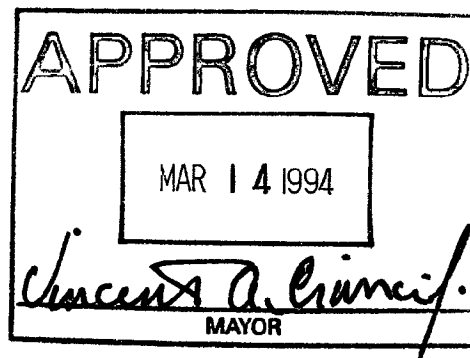
WHEREAS, The President of the City Council is hereby requested to appoint a Special Committee for the purpose of studying and re-dedication of Kennedy Plaza, and



