CHAPTER 666, BY ADDING THE SUM OF FIFTEEN HUNDRED (\$1500) DOLLARS
TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 5.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 666 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 22, 1952, and entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$28,328,060.70 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1953", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500) Dollars to the appropriation contained therein for POLICE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 5.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by transferring a like amount from POLICE DEPARTMENT, ITEM C.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
