AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT ALL LICENSED ESTABLISHMENTS WHICH SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, IN THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE PLACE A NOTICE IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE INDICATING: "ATTENTION: THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE INJURIOUS TO YOUR HEALTH PARTICULARLY TO PREGNANT WOMEN AND THEIR FETUSES, AS AMENDED.

Approved

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. All licensed establishments which sell alcoholic beverages, as licensed by the Board of Licenses, of the City of Providence, are hereby required to conspicuously place a notice to be designed by said Board, that shall indicate the following; "Attention: The Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages may be Injurious to Your Health Particularly to Pregnant Women and Their Fetuses."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its Passage.




Dear Chairman Glavin:
