

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 84

Approved February 14, 1974

RESOLVED, DECREED, AND ORDERED,

That the following named highway shown as a cross-hatched area on accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works-Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 063803, Dated: November 8, 1973,"

viz:

Conduit Street (portion) from Stewart Street easterly for a distance of two hundred feet (200')<sup>±</sup>, more or less, having ceased to be useful to the public, and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded subject to the condition incorporated in communication from the Department of Public Works, as incorporated in communication addressed to Chairman, Committee on Public Works, dated November 13, 1973, a copy of which is hereto attached, as it concerns an existing 12-inch combination sewer and, further, subject to the condition incorporated in communication from the Chief Engineer, Water Supply Board, dated October 15, 1973, addressed to Chairman, Committee on Public Works, a copy of which is hereto attached, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works be, and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway," and it is further,

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.

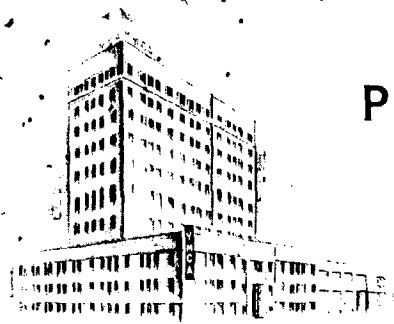

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works is a proposal for the abandonment of that portion of Conduit Street from Stewart Street easterly for a distance of 200 ft.<sup>+</sup> to the westerly line of Lot 193. The petition is by the Greater Providence YMCA.

Inspection revealed that the land abutting the section of Conduit Street in question is in use as the YMCA parking lot. To the south, Lot 197 is the site of a recently demolished industrial building, Lots 196 and 195 are vacant.



Request: To abandon as a Public Highway that portion of Conduit Street from Stewart Street, easterly for a distance of Two Hundred (200') Feet ±, more or less.

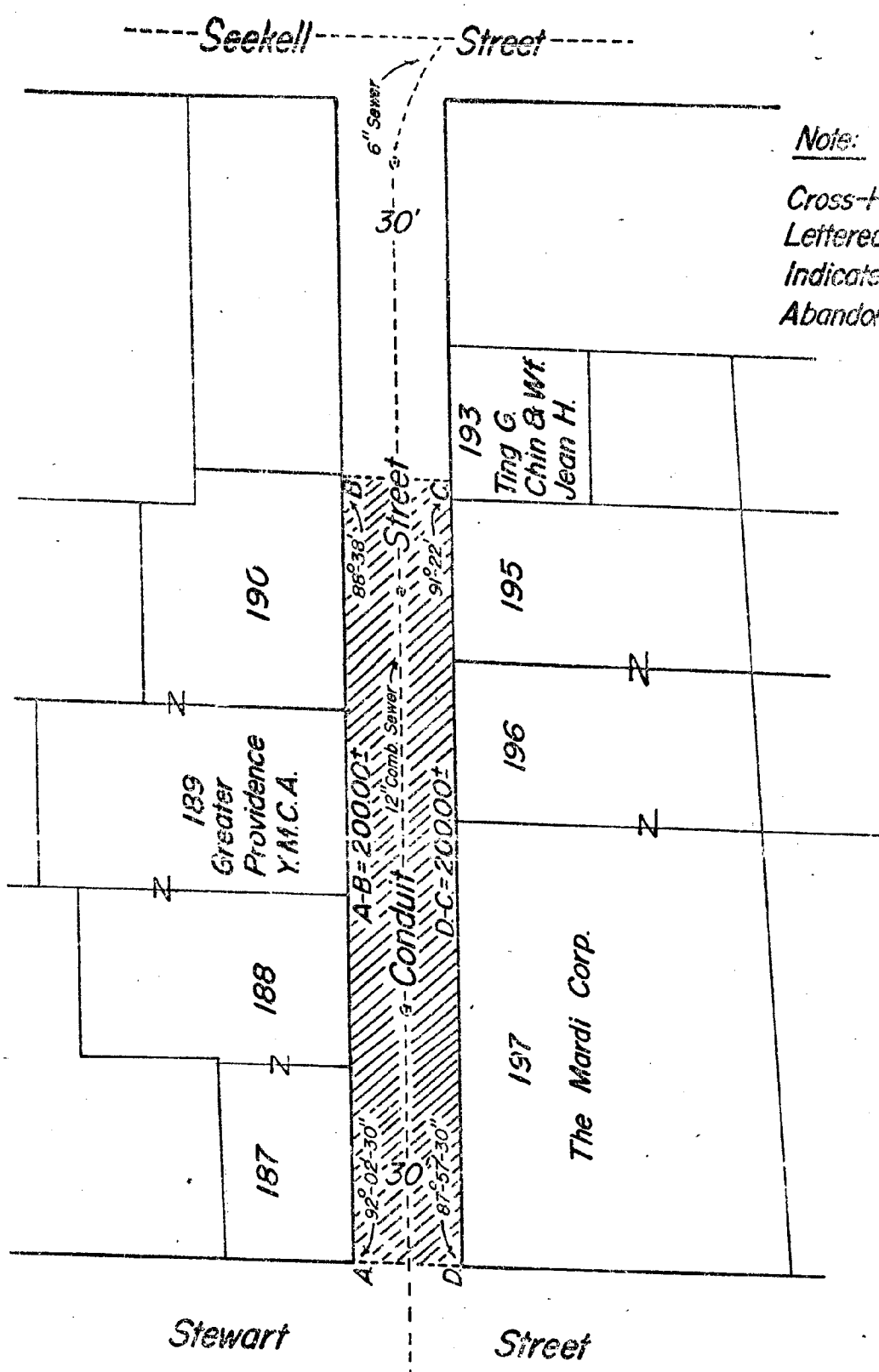
Disposition: This department feels that the entire length of Conduit Street should be abandoned to the Service Road.

### MEMORANDUM

TO: Councilman Payne

SUBJECT: PROPOSED ABANDONMENT OF CONDUIT STREET

CONSIDERED BY: City Clerk Vincent Vespia

DISPOSITION: Pursuant to your request that both Conduit Street and Durfee Street petitions be transmitted to the City Council with recommendation the same be granted, I submit the following report:

With respect to Durfee Street, the proposal of the Providence Redevelopment Agency, incorporated in its report to you dated January 24, 1974, will be a part of the accompanying Resolution in that the sewer line, which passes under this street, shall remain in its present location and that the agency maintain an easement; therefore, the subject petition, with an accompanying amended Resolution, will be transmitted to the City Council with recommendation for adoption subject to a poll of the other members of your Committee.

With respect to the petition concerning Conduit Street, Deputy Public Works Director Campo informs that as reported in Director McGarry's report of November 13, 1973, wherein "does not recommend the abandonment of Conduit Street, etc. because of an existing 12-inch combination sewer, which will have to remain in service" he, Campo, is of the opinion that the only solution that could negate this recommendation is that the existing 12-inch combination sewer become a private drain owned by the abutting owners to be maintained at their expense. This, he suggests with tongue-in-cheek, in that it appears other abutting owners, other than those joining in the petition, are now serviced by that said sewer; and although not a part to the original petition to abandon Conduit Street would be affected, such as a sewer discharge fee could be charged for all persons who would be serviced by this prospective private drain if agreed to by the abutting owners.

Accordingly, Mr. Chairman, it is suggested that this matter be continued and not recommended for the reasons above stated.
