Highland Avenue.

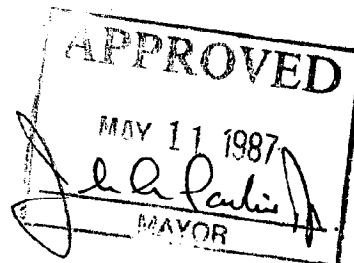


Dear Sir:

WHEREAS, There is an increased number of traffic accidents and traffic hazards at the intersections of Angell and Waterman Streets and Thayer, Hope and Cooke Streets,

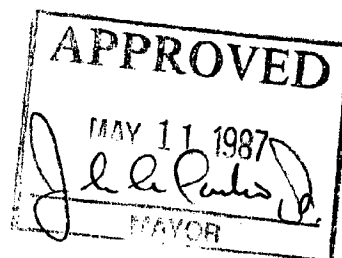
