# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 574

Approved September 18, 1987

WHEREAS, the General Assembly, in its January Session A.D. 1987, passed "An Act Authorizing the State of Rhode Island to issue General Obligation Bonds and Notes in an Amount Not to Exceed \$65,200,000 for the Purpose of Acquiring and Preserving Open Spaces and Recreational Areas" (the "State Open Space Act") which is subject to approval at a special state-wide election to be held November 3, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly, in its September Session, A. D. 1987, passed "An Act Authorizing the Cities and Towns of Rhode Island to Issue General Obligation Bonds and Notes For the Purpose of Acquiring, Preserving, Restoring or Improving Recreational Areas" (the "Municipal Open Space Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Open Space Act requires the City Council of Providence to adopt a resolution which directs that the approval of the Municipal Open Space Act be submitted to the electors, provides for an exact amount of bonds and notes to be issued, and specifies whether such issuance of bonds or notes is contingent upon the passage of the State Open Space Act.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That, at a special election to be held on November 3, 1987, there shall be submitted to the electors of the City of Providence, a proposition in substantially the following form:

"Shall the City of Providence issue General Obligation Bonds and Notes in an amount not to exceed \$15,000,000 for the Purpose of Acquiring and Preserving Open Space and Acquiring, Preserving, Restoring or Improving Recreational Areas?"


AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the issuance of the City's General Obligation Bonds and Notes shall not be contingent upon the State's being authorized to issue Bonds and Notes pursuant to the State Open Space Act, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Mayor and the Canvassing Authority shall take any and all action necessary or desirable to implement the special election and place the question on the ballot.


