No. 109 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING CHAPTER 544 OF 1951 BY CHANGING FROM AN R-4 MULTIPLE DWELLING ZONE TO A C-4 HEAVY COMMERCIAL ZONE, LOTS 502, 503, 750, 749, 507, 508, 740 AND 504, AS SET OUT AND DELINEATED ON CITY ASSESSOR'S PLAT 68; SAID LOTS BEING DESIGNATED AS 112-114 DOUGLAS AVENUE, 410-434 CHALKSTONE AVENUE AND 25 WAYNE STREET.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations", is hereby further amended by changing from an R-4 Multiple Dwelling Zone to a C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone, Lots 502, 503, 750, 749, 507, 508, 740 and 504, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 68; said lots being designated as 112-114 Douglas Avenue, 410-434 Chalkstone Avenue and 25 Wayne Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the southerly line of Chalkstone Avenue at the northwesterly corner of Lot 740 on City Assessor's Plat 68; thence easterly along the southerly line of Chalkstone Avenue to the southwesterly line of Douglas Avenue; thence southeasterly along the southwesterly line of Douglas Avenue to the northerly line of Wayne Street at the southeasterly corner of Lot 502; thence westerly along the northerly line of Wayne Street to the southwesterly corner of Lot 504; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lot 505 to the northwesterly corner of Lot 504; thence westerly along the northerly lines of Lots 505, 506 and 509 to the southwesterly corner of Lot 508; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lot 509 to the northerly line of Wayne Street at the southeasterly corner of Lot 740; thence westerly along the northerly line of Wayne Street to the southwesterly corner of Lot 740; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lot 741 to the southerly line of Chalkstone Avenue at the northwesterly corner of Lot 740 and the point and place of beginning.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

AND DOUGLAS AVENUES FROM R-4 to C-4

Gentlemen:

These petitions, from the Committee on Ordinances, concern the proposed rezoning of an area of 29,659 sq. ft. presently zoned R-4 to be changed to C-4. The land consists of Lot No. 505 (referral No. 1803) and Lots 502, 503, 750, 749, 507, 508, 740 and 504 (referral No. 1804) all in Assessor's Plat 68 at the intersection of Chalkstone and Douglas Avenues.


Inspection revealed that this tract of land is presently occupied by fourteen residential buildings containing over 20 dwelling units all in poor to fair condition. Across Chalkstone Ave. from the proposed site is a parcel of land of similar size recently rezoned to C-4 and now occupied by a large modern gasoline service station. The neighborhood is on the boundary of the "Smith Hill" neighborhood close to where it is ended by the U.S. Route 95 Connector and the Randall Square clearance area.

The nearby presence of the newly rezoned C-4 area with its huge modern service station makes inadvisable the demolition of these 20 low rent dwelling units for the probable side-by-side location of another service station. To allow this zone change would be poor planning and not in the best interest of the people of the city.

The Commission

VOTED: To recommend that this petition be denied.





Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Section 21-14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, effective October 21, 1968, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No petition for an amendment to the zoning Ordinance, including the zoning map, shall be accepted by the clerk of the City Council, unless accompanied by a filing fee of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, which shall be deposited with the City Clerk, and no part of which shall be returnable to the petitioner."
