WHEREAS, Caxton Street is intersected at one point, by private property, and

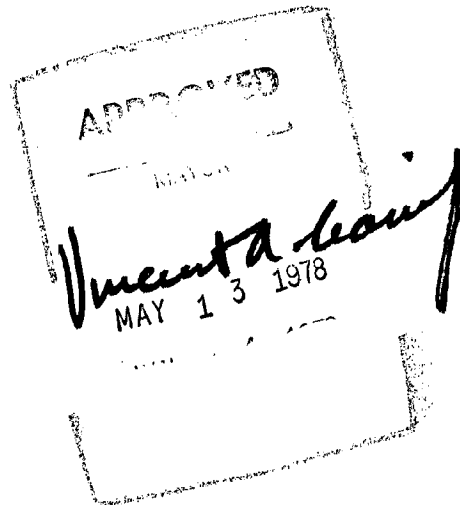
