



A RESOLUTION OF THE PROVIDENCE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

No. 916

Approved August 29, 1961

WHEREAS, the Official Redevelopment Plan for Central-Classical Project No. R. I. R-2 as approved and adopted by chapter 1419 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence approved August 11, 1961 states on page 13 that said plan is consistent with the requirements of the Master Plan of the City of Providence with respect to appropriate land uses including recreational and community facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Providence in adopting an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for Central-Classical Project No. R. I. R-2" made a finding that said plan conformed to the Master Plan of the City of Providence; and

WHEREAS, Section 315 of the Housing Act of 1961, (42 USC 1455) requires that local governing bodies make a specific finding with respect to the provision of adequate park and recreational facilities in its approval of a Redevelopment Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the PROVIDENCE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY as follows:

1. That the Executive Director is hereby authorized and directed to request the Providence City Council to clarify their findings by adding the following thereto:

That it is hereby found and determined that the Official Redevelopment Plan for Central-Classical Project No. R. I. R-2 gives due consideration to the provision of adequate park and recreational areas and facilities, as may be desirable for neighborhood improvement, with special consideration for the health, safety, and welfare of children residing in the general vicinity of the site covered by the Plan.

2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
