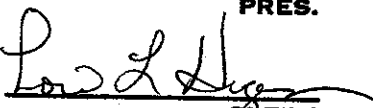

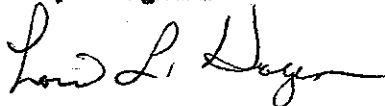

On 11 October 2011, the Board of Contract & Supply approved the request to begin the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Port Security Grant, EMW-201\_PU-APP-00213 *Maritime Radar Project*. This project was completed in December 2013; it is part the of the Rhode Island Common Operating Picture (RICOP) system.

The Rhode Island Emergency Management Agency (RIEMA), Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM) and the Providence Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) are partners in the management, maintenance and integration of the Rhode Island Common Operating Picture (RICOP).

To ensure the RICOP system remains operational and available on a 24/7/365 basis the State of Rhode Island has identified federal funding for preventative maintenance and repairs.

The prime contractor for this project is Raytheon, 1847 W. Main Road, Portsmouth, RI 02871.

I request to add an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 to the grant bringing the total to \$457,800.00
