

WHEREAS, The Providence City Council is hereby requested to create a Committee on Recreation for the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, The said Committee would be in charge of the responsibility to meet with the Director of Recreation and his/her subordinates and Members of the Recreational Advisory Board, and

WHEREAS, This newly created Committee would meet in order that some concrete discussion would be made relative to the management and delivery of services to the Providence Taxpayer, and

WHEREAS, Rule 20 (c) of the said Rules of the City Council does hereby provide for the creation of all Special Committees of the City Council, and

WHEREAS, That pursuant to Rule 20 (c) of the Rules of the Providence City Council, a Special Committee on Recreation is hereby created.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the charge of said Special Committee shall meet with the Director of Recreation, subordinates and any other City Officials which it may deem necessary for the purpose of advising the City Council as to the proper management and delivery of services to the people of the City of Providence, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Special Committee shall consist of five (5) Members of the City Council who shall be appointed by the President of the City Council or the Council President Pro Tempore pursuant to said Rule 20 (c) and that the term of said Special Committee shall expire on January 1, 1996.
