
Dear Councilman Lombardi:

On May 23, 1998, BankBoston Hospital Trust will merge into BankBoston, N.A. and will conduct business in Rhode Island as BankBoston. At that time and in keeping with our new identity, we would like to change the street address of our downtown Providence Hospital Trust Tower Building from One Hospital Trust Plaza to One BankBoston Plaza. The building itself would become The BankBoston Tower.

Over the last few years, BankBoston has made a multi-million dollar commitment to downtown Providence through exclusive renovations to the Tower Building's lobbies, sidewalks, public plaza area and fountain. It is our intention to remain the premier commercial facility downtown, while adding substantially to the number of bank employees located here.


I am writing to you in regards to the address name change resolution now pending before the Committee.

Thank you for notifying us of the pending resolution to change One Hospital Plaza to One BankBoston Plaza. We have already discussed this change with a representative of BankBoston and appreciated their letting us know so far in advance. We have notified the Delivery Station and our Address Information Systems Department of the pending change.

We would agree with this change on one crucial condition: that BankBoston commits to notifying the tenants and enforcing their use of the new, proper address. We know there will be a brief grace period for continuing to use the old address, but we cannot promise that those tenants who continue to use the old address after that period will not see delays in their mail delivery.


