

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved March 12, 2002

WHEREAS, On the district level, he went through the chairs to become a Fourth District Commander, then after the transition to countries, Fourth County Commander for two years, and

WHEREAS, After serving on various committees in post district and department, Comarde Lawrence is ending two years as National Vice Chairman, Americanism Council. Now that a term is over as President of the Past Commanders Club, Macon is now seeking to advance even further in the American Legion, and

WHEREAS, Upon his retirement from military service, Macon Lawrence was employed at General Dynamics where he was an employee, also for twenty years. During the time at General Dynamics, Macon acquired a B.S. Degree in Business Administration from Johnson & Wales University; and

WHEREAS, Service to the American Legion, he is a Paid up for Life Member of Post Number 69, Past Post Commander, Past Fourth District Commander, Past Co-Chairman of Department President of the past Commanders Club. Presently he is serving as Department Senior Vice Commander, and is ending a third year as Vice Chairman of the National Americanism Council.
