





On an inspection and photographic survey it was found that Elk Street and the abutting northerly portion of land had been surfaced for use as private parking; also, West River Street was curbed and paved but had many surface deficiencies.


Reference is made to Referral No. 1122, from the Committee on Public Works, dated November 25, 1959, at which time a request was submitted to abandon a portion of West River Street. The City Plan Commission VOTED: To offer no objection to abandon that portion of West River Street as a public highway.
