


RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL




RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

RESOLVED, That Sincere Congratulations are hereby extended to Detective Patricia L. Cornell, upon receiving the Chief's Award, who on August 28, 1999, responded to Mitchell Street to process a murder scene, and upon arriving on scene learned the victim was shot to death and the suspect vehicle abandoned on Whitney Street, Detective Cornell processed both scenes, but it was the burned out vehicle on Whitney Street that proved the most difficult yet yielded the identity of the assailant. Latent prints were lifted from the wet, burned out vehicle which matched the suspect and led to his arrest and murder charge.




RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
