No. 410 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1984-53 APPROVED JULY 20, 1984, BY TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.00) FROM (1-018-01-211) PUBLIC PROPERTY; MOTOR FUEL TO (1-018-01-501) PUBLIC PROPERTY; OFFICE EQUIPMENT AND FURNITURE.

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 1984-53 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, as approved July 20, 1984, entitled: "An Ordinance making an Appropriation of One Hundred Seventy-One Million, Fifty Six Thounsand, One Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars and Fifty Seven Cents. (\$171,056,177.57) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, as amended", is hereby further amended by transferring the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) from (1-018-01-211) Public Property; Motor Fuel to (1-018-01-501) Public Property; Office Equipment and Furniture.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

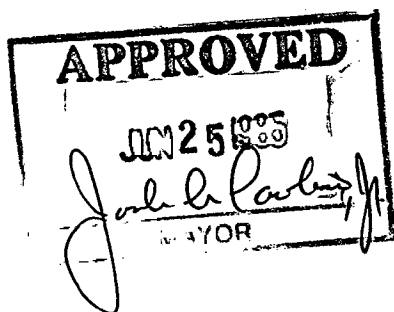
