

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 669

Approved October 27, 1977

WHEREAS, certain tax exempt entities in the City of Providence are continually acquiring real property, often the same have been held by tax paying owners, thus removing the same from tax rolls, which increases the tax burden upon other taxpayers in the City, and

WHEREAS, certain other tax exempt entities are making voluntary contributions, in lieu of taxes, which aids the City in financing service obligations to its Citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Acting City Solicitor is requested to prepare, cause to be introduced, and to urge the passage of An Act whereby all tax exemptions legislation on real property in the City of Providence, be granted only upon approval by Resolution of the City Council of Providence, so that the City may call upon such entities to voluntarily contribute financial assistance.
