Approved March 26, 1993

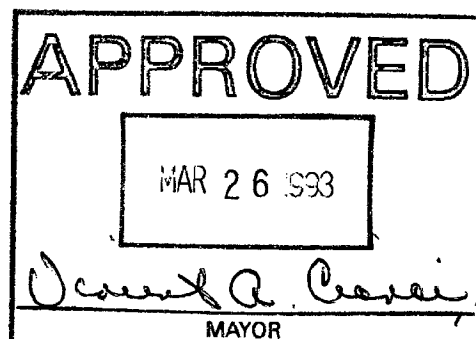

WHEREAS, They have continued to paint over the graffiti several times over,

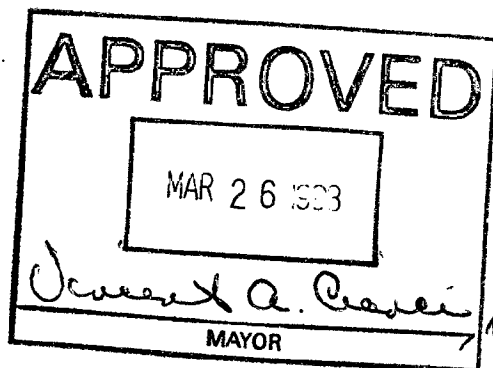
