The following memo is a response to resolution 6 to be heard at the 1/17/18 Public Works Committee Meeting

1. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of speed humps or other traffic calming measures on Melissa St.

**Response:** There is currently a request for traffic calming on Melissa St. that is to be heard by the Traffic Calming Advisory Group. It is estimated that the TCAG will review this request in the Fall of 2018. Traffic Engineering evaluated an all-way stop condition at the Barbera St./Melissa St intersection. It was determined that the intersection did not meet the criteria for an all-way stop condition.
