No. 353 **AN ORDINANCE** CREATING PROOF OF OWNERSHIP OF
DOG PRIOR TO COMMITTING SAID DOG TO AN AUTHORIZED AGENT OF THE CITY.

Approved June 8, 1977

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Sec. 4-34.1 is hereby added to the Ordinances of the City of Providence creating proof of ownership of dog prior to committing said dog to an authorized agent of the city, and reads as follows:

"Sec. 4-34.1. Any one attempting to commit or have detained or impound any dog to a police officer, dog officer or other individuals authorized by the City to exercise such control must first sign an affidavit that he or she is the true owner of said animal."

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by the City Council and approved by the Mayor.
