RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 576

Approved November 25, 1974

WHEREAS, On November 11, 1974, Charles L. Hareld, Jr. of East Providence, Rhode Island, acting with dispatch, averted what may have been a tragedy, when he, recognizing a disabled motor vehicle careening down the Angell Street hill, behind him, towards heavily traveled North Main Street, maneuvered the motor truck he was operating, so that it received the full impact of that disabled vehicle, bringing it to a halt without serious injury to its female operator and with minimum damage to the vehicles involved, and

WHEREAS, this brave young man, not unmindful of the risk to himself, did perform a most extraordinary act of heroism,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that to Charles L. Hareld, Jr. of East Providence is hereby tendered the sincere appreciation of those persons, who may have been victims of a tragedy, were it not for his alertness and contributing courage, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to cause a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution to be transmitted to Charles L. Hareld, Jr. of East Providence, Rhode Island.
