



<i>Agenda Item</i>	<i>Department Response</i>
1. Resolution Requesting the Director of Operations and the Director of Public Works is requested to purchase or lease two asphalt hot boxes.	The Department has acquired one hotbox and we are evaluating the effectiveness of this equipment.
2. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause Amity Street to be converted back to two-way traffic.	One-way streets are under the jurisdiction of the City Council. This Department has no objections to this change.
3. Resolution Requesting the Acting Director of Public Works to recycle street sweeping sand on city streets to be reused in 2014-2015 Winter Season.	An economic evaluation will be made to determine if there are savings to be had from this practice. Also, the environmental concerns will be considered
4. Resolution Requesting the Acting Director of Public Works and the Director of Operations to purchase six (6) Vibco Vibrator Pothole Patcher (Model GR-1600).	This Department has been in contact with the owner of this firm to arrange a demonstration of this equipment.
5. Resolution Requesting the Committee on Public Works be updated on road improvements and quality of work being performed, and remedies initiated to correct problems that have arisen.	This Department is aware that there is a small percentage of the work performed warrants further review and we are working closely with outside consultants and the contractors to establish limits and remedies to the problem areas.
