

Re: The Narragansett Electric Company-Notice of Intent to relocate power lines of less than One Thousand feet (Q-143 and R-144 lines, Providence)

Dear Mr. Hartley:

The Narragansett Electric Company ("Narragansett") is planning to re-route a portion of the Q-143 and R-144 115 kV underground cables in the vicinity of Charles Street and the Amtrak tracks in Providence. Given the limited scope of this project, it is a de minimus transmission line project which does not require a full application and hearing before the EFSB. Please accept this letter and enclosures as a "Notice of Intent" under Rule 1.6 (c) of the EFSB's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

The Q-143 and R-144 underground cables cross under the tracks of the Amtrak mainline north of the Charles Street Bridge (#930.) The undercutting and lowering of the tracks as part of the Northeast Corridor Electrification Project cannot be accomplished with the cables in their present location. Therefore, Narragansett will relocate approximately 650 feet of each of the circuits as shown on the attached plan (#PD-9841-0.)

A list of Narragansett's affiliates as required by Rule 1.6 (c) (1) is attached.


