WHEREAS, death has taken from this life Sally Gastfreund, late religious and social benefactor of our Community at the age of 56 years, and



WHEREAS, devoted to her religion, she was active in the Temple Emanuel Sisterhood; Hadassah Women's Organization; Pioneer Women's Organization; Providence Hebrew Day School and the Jewish Home for the Aged,


