RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to prohibit motor vehicle traffic along various streets located in the First Ward on various dates and times to accommodate Brown University's 234<sup>th</sup> Commencement Activities.

## **"NO PARKING/EMERGENCY TOW ZONE" SIGNAGE:**
