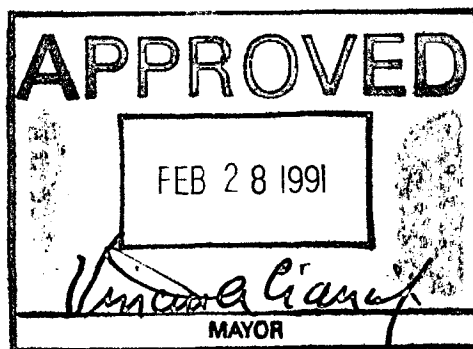

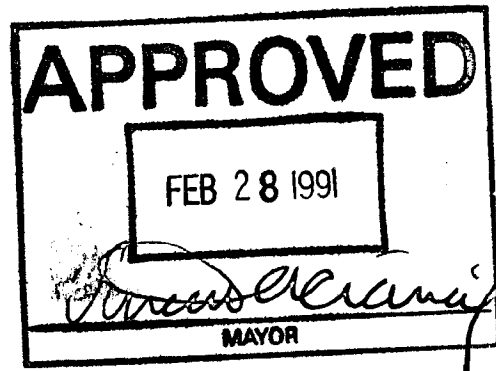

This is in response to the City Council Resolution #128 that was previously forwarded to this office concerning three bridges in the City of Providence.

The Union Avenue, Westminster Street and Broadway Railroad bridges have been included in the Department's Comprehensive Bridge Improvement Program. The Department is currently coordinating these projects very closely with the City of Providence.

We hope to have a project advertised for construction for the Union Avenue bridge over the next few months; subject to receiving approval from Amtrak. In addition, a project should be advertised next spring for improvements to the Broadway Railroad bridge. A project for the Westminster Street bridge will be undertaken when the work on the Broadway Railroad bridge is completed.
