# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved October 15, 1982

WHEREAS, They immediately summoned firefighters and more patrolmen and proceeded to break into the rear door of the building to alert the occupants of the first floor apartments, and

WHEREAS, Patrolmen Peter Mazzei and Paul Verrechia, upon arriving at the scene, immediately entered the building and alerted the second and third floor tenants, and

WHEREAS, The patrolmen entered the smoke-filled structure, without fear of their personal safety thereby leading all occupants safely from the building,

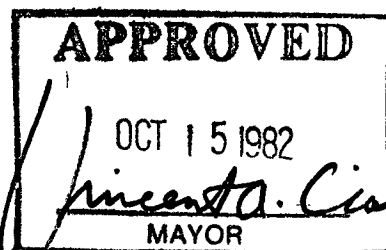
