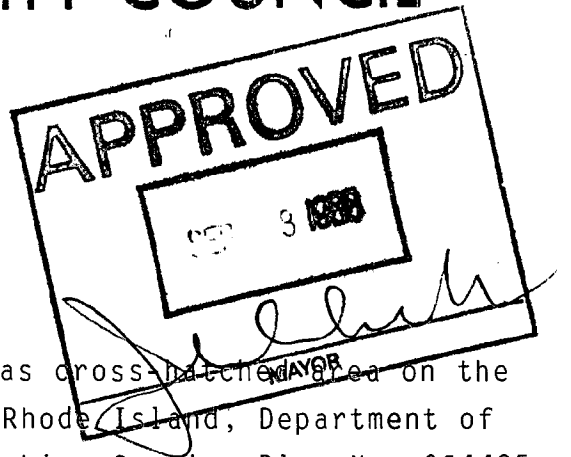

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 448

Approved
September 8, 1988



RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED

That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 064425, dated August 26, 1988",

VIZ:

Hathaway Street (portion of) shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A), having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is proposed to be abandoned as a Public Highway provided that a twelve (12) foot easement shall be granted to the owners of Lots 1136, 1137, 1138, 1139, 1140 and 1141, on Plat 3/2 in the City of Cranston along the southerly border of the abandoned street; and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further,

ORDERED, That the Traffic Engineer, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.

Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission, at its June 14, 1988 regular monthly meeting, reviewed and evaluated the proposed abandonment of Hathaway Street (portion from Stamford Avenue to its termination at lot 292 on Assessor's Plat 89).

The petitioner is Mr. Raymond A. Tomasso of 1258 Elmwood Avenue, Providence, Rhode Island, who owns abutting property: Lot 246 on Assessor's Plat 89 and adjacent Lots 247, 248, 249 and 250.

A field inspection revealed that the subject portion of Hathaway Street is a paper street and the adjacent vacant lots owned by the petitioner are covered with weeds, bushes and trees. The southern side of Hathaway Street borders the Cranston City line. Most of the southern section of the subject portion of Hathaway Street is located on a steep embankment, 18-20 feet high; no physical access is available to properties located along Park Avenue.

Since no negative impact is evident on existing or future land use plans and the development of this portion of the right-of-way is not economically or physically feasible, the staff recommends that the Commission advise the Committee on Public Works that no objection is offered to this petition, subject to notification of abutting owners of land in Cranston and obtaining an opinion from the City Solicitor about a legal appropriation of the entire width of the subject street to the petitioner.

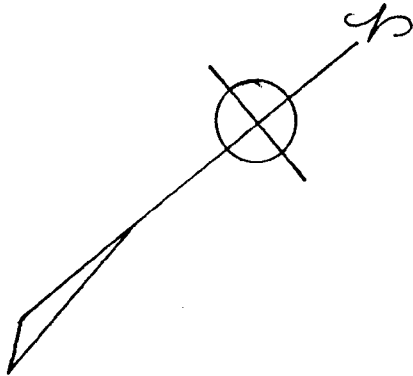

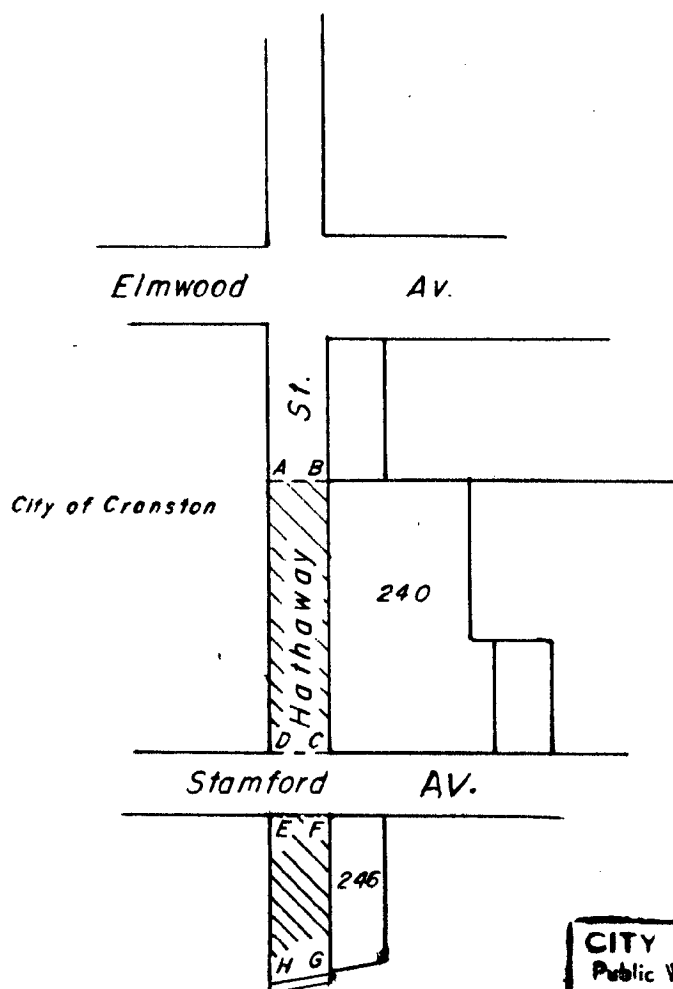
