ELECTION OF SUPERINTENDENT OF BURIAL OF DECEASED SOLDIERS AND SAILORS


COUNCIL PRESIDENT FARGNOLI calls for nominations for Superintendent of Burial of Deceased Soldiers and Sailors and COUNCILMAN ADDISON, nominates HENRY BOUDREAU of Providence, this nomination is seconded by COUNCILMEN FLYNN and GLAVIN.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT FARGNOLI calls for further nominations and there being none, on motion of COUNCILMAN ADDISON, seconded by COUNCILMAN GLAVIN, it is voted that nominations be closed.

On motion of COUNCILMAN ADDISON, seconded by COUNCILMAN GLAVIN, the Clerk be directed to cast one ballot for HENRY BOUDREAU as Superintendent of Burial of Deceased Soldiers and Sailors.

The Clerk casts one ballot as directed.
