WHEREAS, He was appointed to the Providence Fire Department on November 30, 1970, and,

WHEREAS, He was assigned to Ladder 6 at the Atwells Avenue Station until joining the Rescue Service in 1979, and,

WHEREAS, He served the City with great distinction, earning the respect of his colleagues, as well as several meritorious service awards, and,

WHEREAS, Even his own debilitating illness did not diminish his dedication to the Fire Department and its mission of service to the people of Providence; he was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant at a ceremony held at his home on June 12, 1986, and,

WHEREAS, The entire City of Providence mourns the untimely passing of Lieutenant Paul J. Nicotero at forty years of age,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence does pause in its deliberations, out of respect for the memory of Lieutenant Paul J. Nicotero, and,
