No. 239 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 544 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 21, 1951, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, BY CHANGING FROM AN R-4 MULTIPLE DWELLING ZONE TO AN M-1 GENERAL INDUSTRIAL ZONE, LOTS 94, 390, 392, 393, AND 394 AS SET OUT AND DELINEATED ON CITY ASSESSOR'S PLAT 28; SAID LOTS BEING LOCATED IN THE VICINITY OF DEAN AND WEST EXCHANGE STREETS AND BALBO AVENUE.

Approved April 6, 1956

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height, and Area Regulations" is hereby further amended by changing from an R-4 Multiple Dwelling Zone to an M-1 General Industrial Zone, Lots 94, 390, 392, 393, and 394 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 28; said lots being located in the vicinity of Dean and West Exchange Streets and Balbo Avenue, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the southeasterly corner of Balbo Avenue and West Exchange Street; thence easterly along the southerly line of West Exchange Street to the southwesterly corner of West Exchange and Dean Streets; thence southeasterly along the southwesterly line of Dean Street to the southeasterly corner of Lot 94 on Assessor's Plat 28; thence westerly along the southerly lines of Lots 94 and 390 to the easterly line of Balbo Avenue and the southwesterly corner of Lot 390; thence northerly along the said easterly line of Balbo Avenue to the southeasterly corner of Balbo Avenue and West Exchange Street and the point and place of beginning.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 770 - ZONING CHANGE IN THE VICINITY OF DEAN, WEST EX-
CHANGE STREETS AND BALBO AVENUE

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, January 24, 1956.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from an R-4 to an M-1 Zone of Lots 92, 390, 392, 393 and 394 on Assessor's Plat 28, located in the vicinity of Dean, West Exchange Streets, and Balbo Avenue. The area in question contains 12,724 square feet.

Reference is made to Referral No. 751 from the Committee on Ordinances, which requested a change in zoning from an R-4 Zone to an M-1 Zone of Lot 392 on Assessor's Plat 28. The City Plan Commission offered no objection to the granting of the petition. No action has been taken by the City Council at this date.

On the field trip it was found that the area is occupied by two- and four-family dwellings which contain stores on the ground floors.

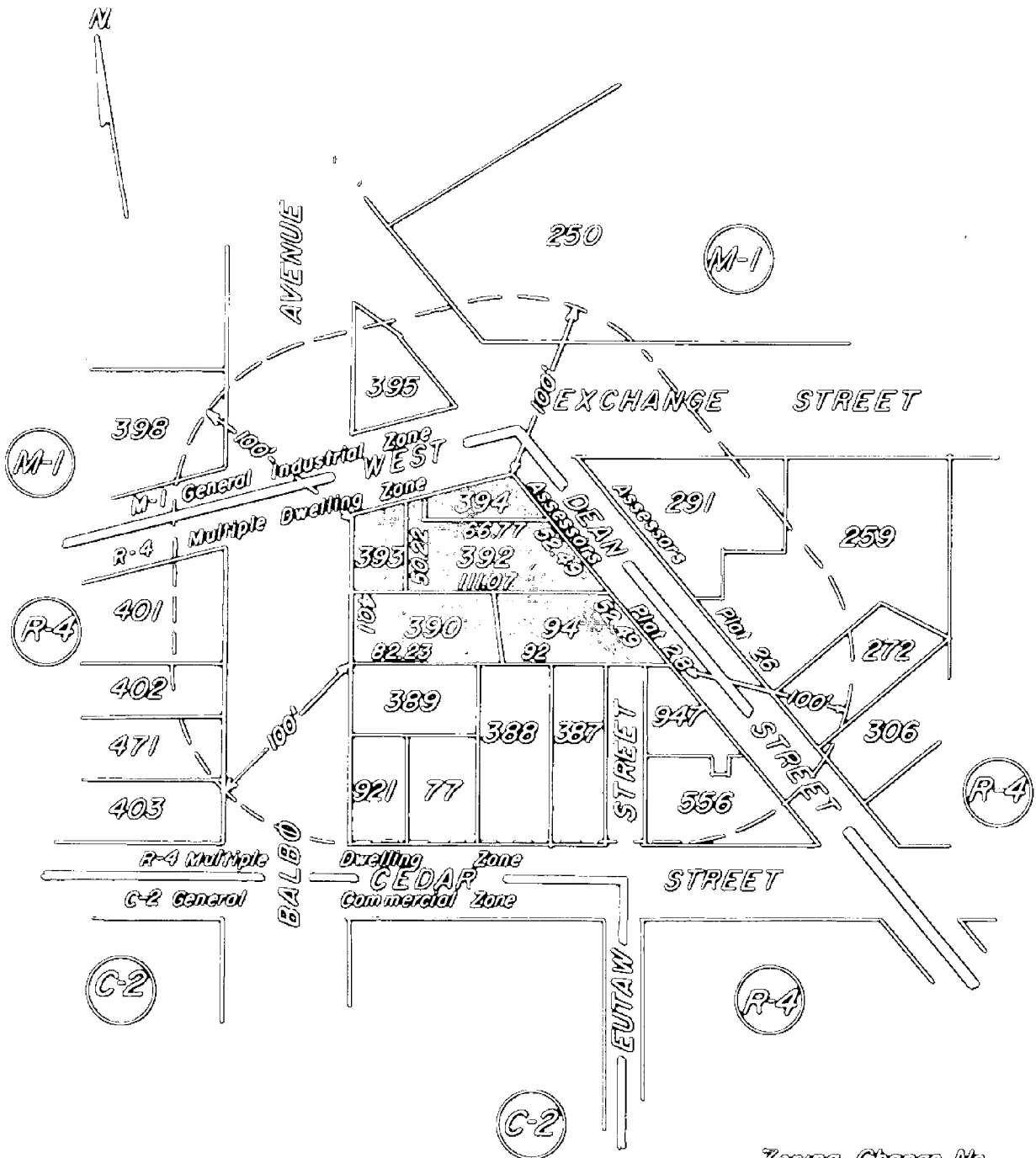

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 987 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 16, 1955, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$31,832,600.04 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1956", as amended, is hereby fruther amended by adding the sum of Seventeen Thousand (\$17,000) Dollars to the appropriation contained therein for RECREATION DEPARTMENT, ITEMS 0, 2, 5 and 7. SECTION 1: Chapter 987 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 16, 1955, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$31,832,600.04 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1956", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Thirty Five Hundred (\$3500) Dollars to an account to be known as "NORTH BURIAL GROUND APPROPRIATION ACCOUNT".

SECTION 2: The said sum of Thirty Five Hundred (\$3500) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Thirty Five Hundred (\$3500) Dollars.

SECTION 4: The City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to pay over this appropriation to the North Burial Ground Fund in the Revolving Fund Accounts.
