

SUBJECT: Referral No. 519 - ZONING CHANGE ON THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF BRANCH AVENUE

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, August 25, 1953.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from an R-3 Zone to an M-1 Zone, Lot 146 on Assessor's Plat 99 located on the southerly side of Branch Avenue, and containing 152,920 square feet of land area.


On the field trip it was found that the area in question is at present vacant. Adjoining the area up for consideration and fronting on Branch Avenue to the east is the Wanskuck Boys Club; to the west there lie one and two-family dwellings. To the north lies a mixture of commercial and residential structures. In a preliminary plan of the proposed Louisquisset Freeway a portion of Lot 146 lies in the land-take area of the proposed route. The Wanskuck Company has stated that the property is for sale and will command a higher price if the zoning is changed.

In view of the above, and because the introduction of an M-1 use in this area will tend to contribute to the traffic congestion on an already overloaded artery, and since the use will not be in harmony with the character of the neighborhood and to avoid a case of spot zoning,

The Commission

VOTED: To recommend to the Committee on Ordinances that this petition be denied.
