

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 281

Approved September 14, 2020

WHEREAS, During the July 31, 2020 special meeting of the Providence City Council, the Council passed a resolution requesting that the General Assembly authorize the City to obtain a \$140-million school improvement bond; and

WHEREAS, The proposed school improvement bond cannot be obtained without first obtaining authorization by a vote of the qualified electors of the City; and

WHEREAS, On their November Ballot, Providence voters will see a ballot question asking if they support the proposed \$140-million school improvement bond; and

WHEREAS, If approved, the \$140-million bond will be used to finance the construction, renovation, improvement, alteration, repair, landscaping, furnishing and equipping of schools and school facilities throughout the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council encourages all residents to vote "Yes" on the November ballot referendum to approve the proposed \$140-million bond for school improvement projects throughout the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of Providence, the Superintendent of the Providence Public School District, and the Commissioner of Elementary and Secondary Education for the State of Rhode Island.


