

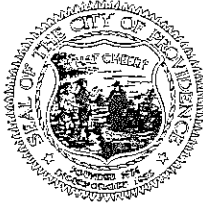



Bid Comments:

***Autiello:** It has been determined to be in Providence Water and the City of Providence best interest to classify Autiello's bid response as non-responsive, and therefore has not been included in the above bid evaluation. Bonding capability only \$8M. Project cost estimate = \$10M, substantially less than Schematic Design Estimate (indicates lack of understanding of project scope). Did not list any project references over \$10M. Incomplete proposal; did not provide General Conditions breakdown. Did not schedule any site visits for bidding subcontractors.


***Burman:** RFP required minimum five reference projects of \$10M or greater; only provided 2 such projects. Resumes not provided for all team members. Estimate breakdown was not provided in original response. Follow-up breakdown provided had numerical errors (some items did not match numbers in fee proposal).


***Gilbane:** Did not include CM Payment & Performance Bond in quote. Did not provide complete General Conditions table. Permit fees were not included in the cost estimate.


***Turgeon:** Resumes not provided for all team members. Did not provide federally funded projects list in original response as required in the RFP. No litigation history provided. No formal schedule provided in original response.

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend award to Dimeo Construction the lowest qualified bidder in the amount of \$16,300,000 as per the above evaluation.
The Awarded amount is the current Budget for the project.
